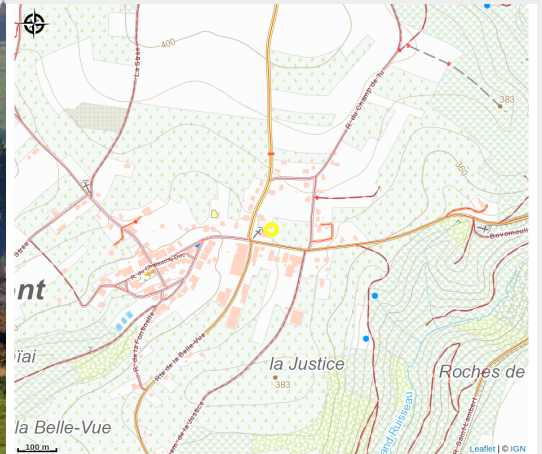

Description

In Ucimont is the Château Le Duc. This castle was built by the owners of the Paliseul estate who farmed land on the plateau, which had no natural defence.

The Germanic and Norman invasions required the increased protection that the site of Château Le Duc could offer, squeezed between two tributaries of the Grand Ruisseau. Its origin dates back to the 9th century.

In Ucimont, you will also find the small museums of the "Lavandières" and the tools of the past.
