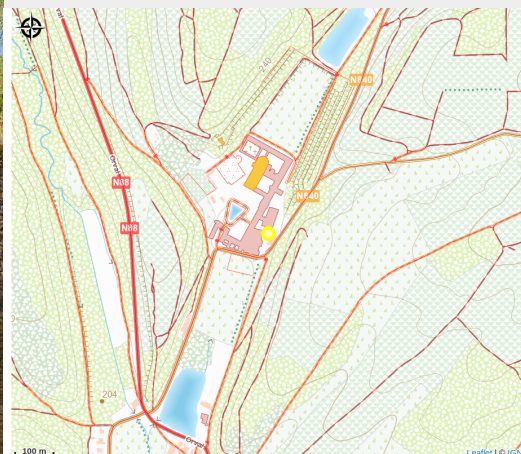


The Abbey of Orval : its ruins and its museums

The Abbey of Orval is one of the most remarkable Cistercian abbeys of Belgium. Discover the medicinal herbs garden and the museum of the traditional pharmacy. 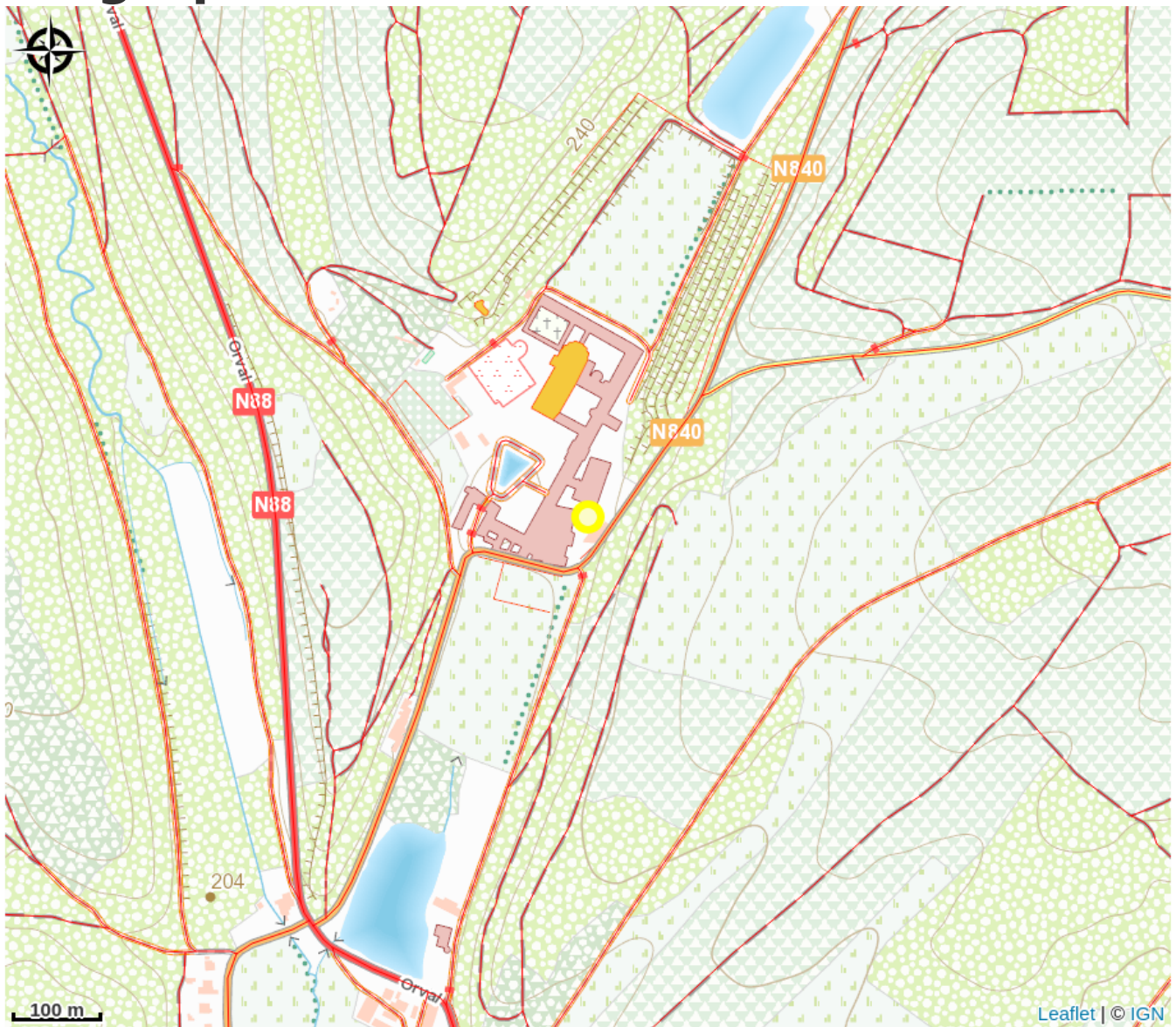
