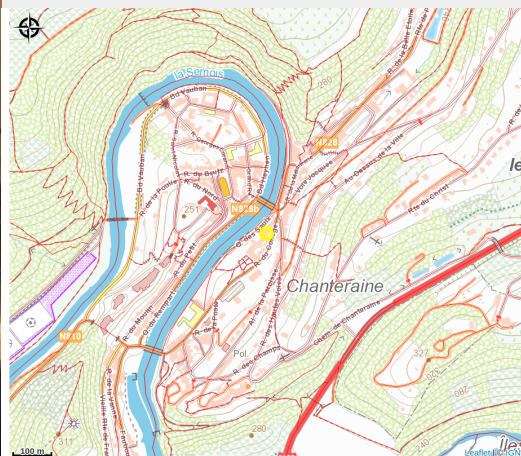

Joint tickets for the Castle, the Archeoscope and the Ducal Museum are available.

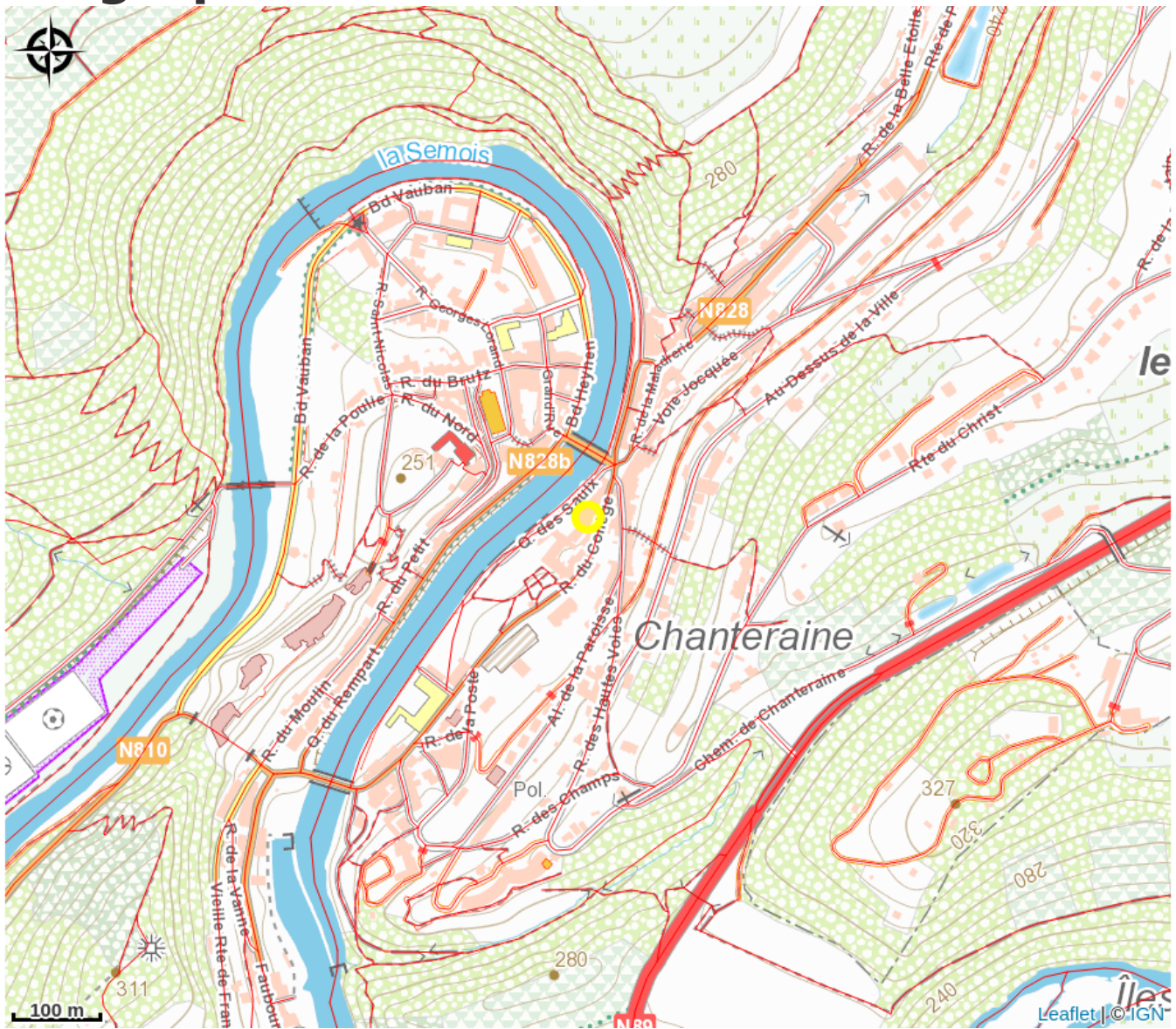
