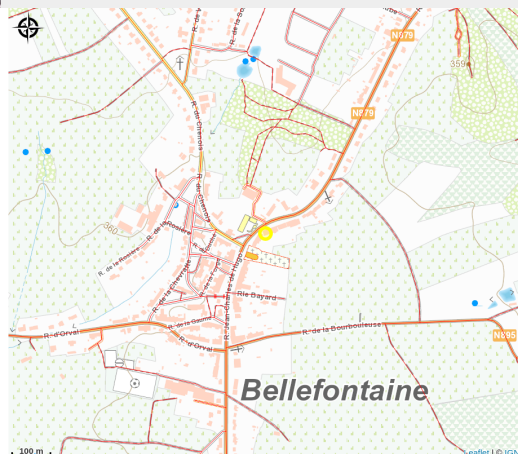


Arboretum and nature reserves of Bellefontaine

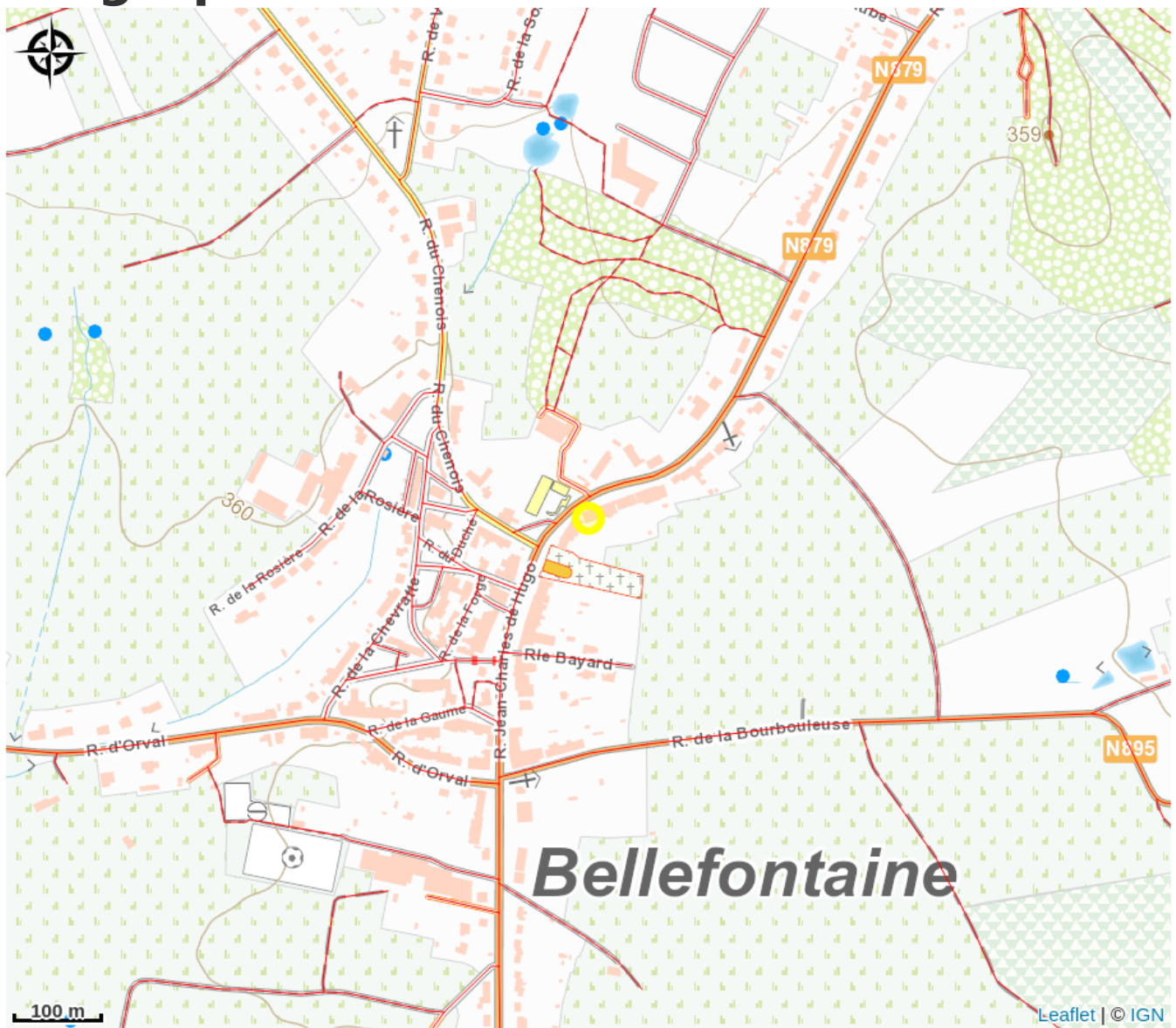
Description

Blackthorn, pedunculate oak, smooth-leaved elm... Lilted names. Are you able to identify those species ? No ? A visit to Bellefontaine's arboretum is then highly recommended. No imported species, only species from around here, which a didactic trail will introduce you to over designation plates. Along of strolled about paths on the 4 hectares of this park, some benches invite you to relaxation and reverie, enjoying the undisturbed and magical feel of the place. Children can play around at the outstanding discovery playfield, away from the street's bustle. Blackthorn, pedunculate oak, field elm... wonderful sounding names. Can you identify these species? No? Then you definitely need to visit the arboretum in Bellefontaine. There are no imported species in this arboretum: you will only find species native to Belgium on this educational route. While wandering along footpaths around the 4-hectare estate, take a break and relax on a bench while enjoying the tranquillity and magic of this place. There is a playground for children and exciting discoveries to be made away from the hustle and bustle of the street.
