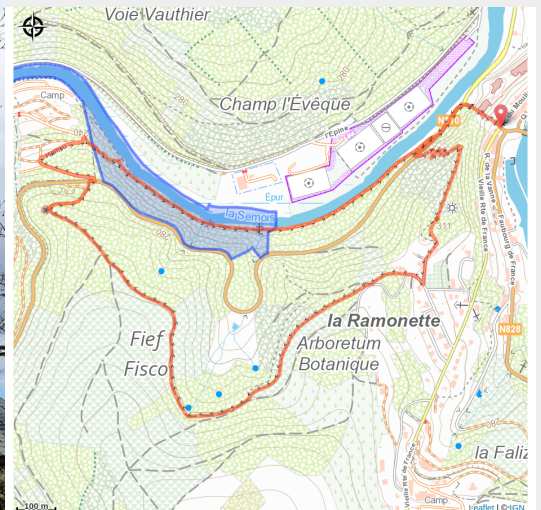

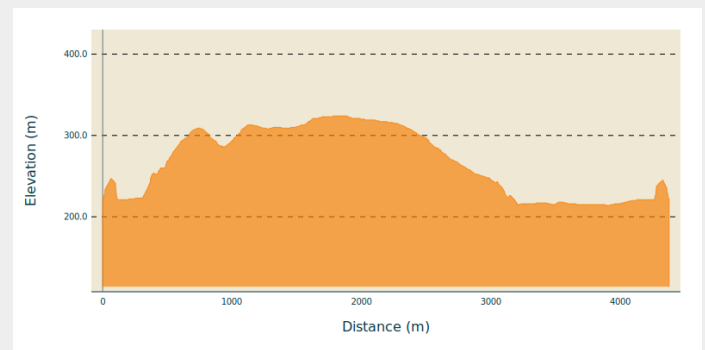

Magnificent walk, a little dizzying along the ridge. Multiple interests: archaeological, historical, cultural, landscape. Walk near the town of Bouillon. Passage through the Ramonette, which is the oldest place of military occupation of the town, the first watchtower dates from the early Middle Ages. Pass through the geographical and botanical arboretum. Return via a romantic path along the Semois.
