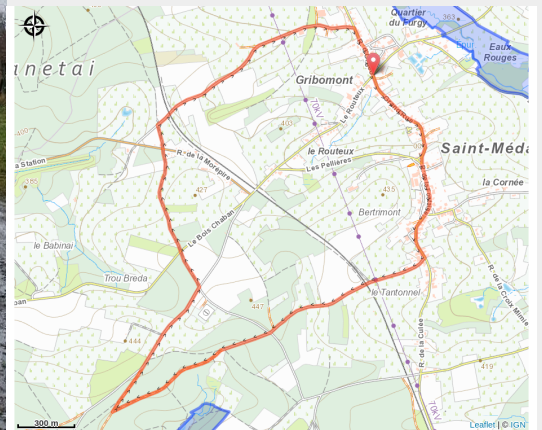

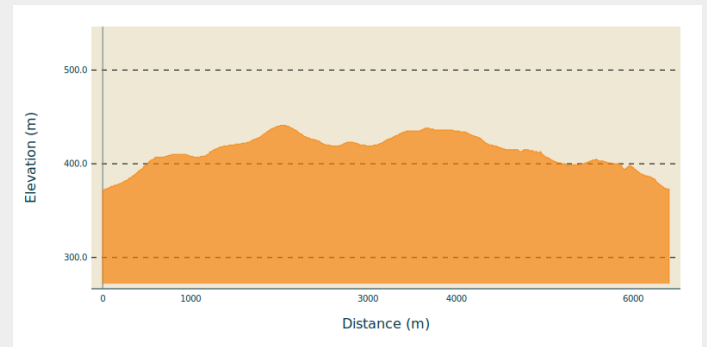

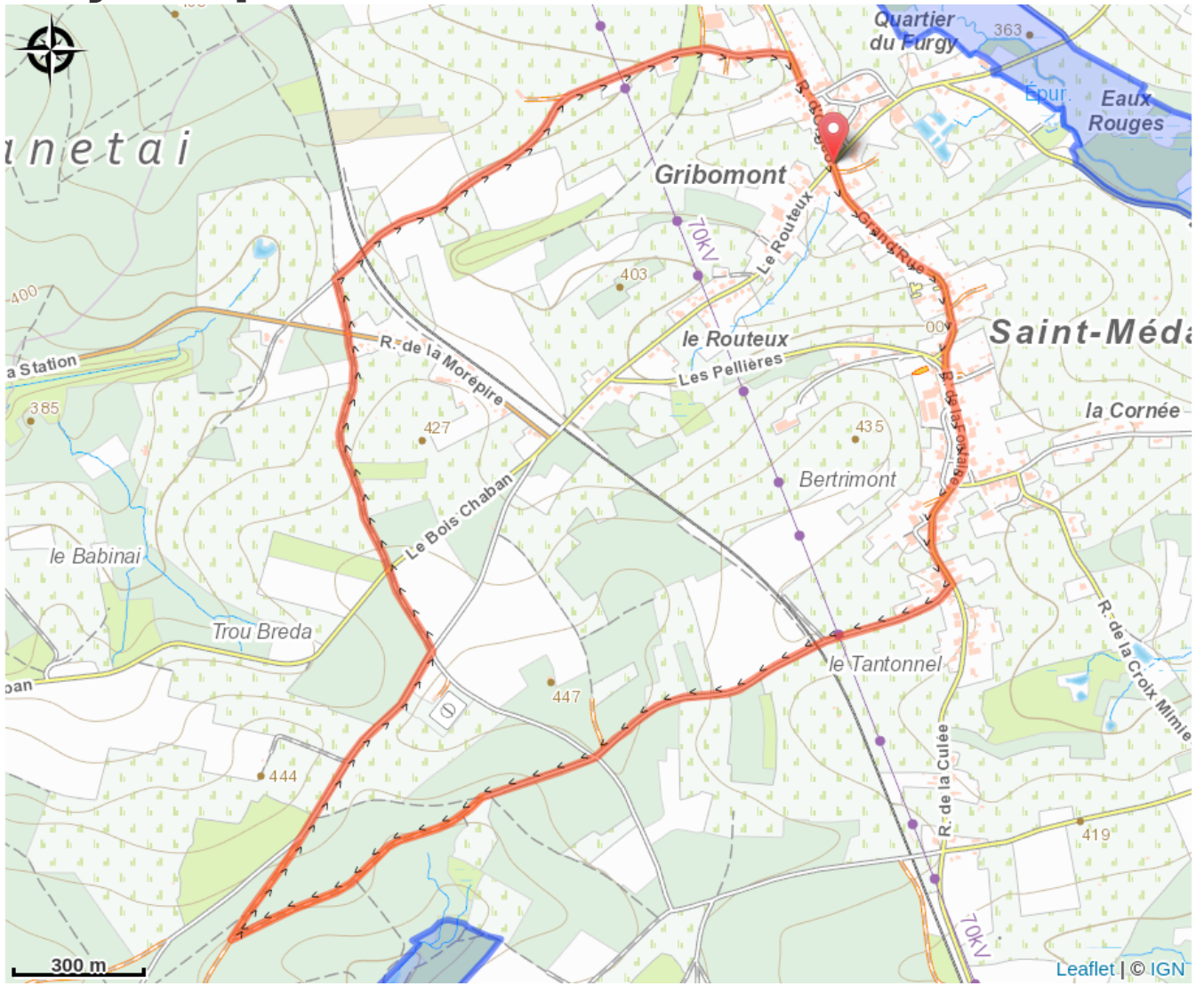
Family walk starting from the Place de Gribomont. It will take you to the small Coquerains wood and the facilities of the brand new 'FC Herbeumont' football club.
