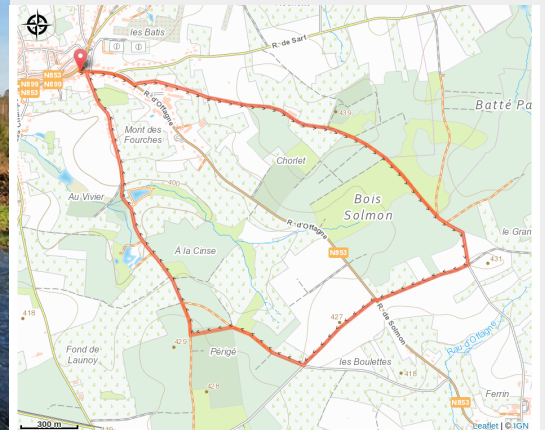

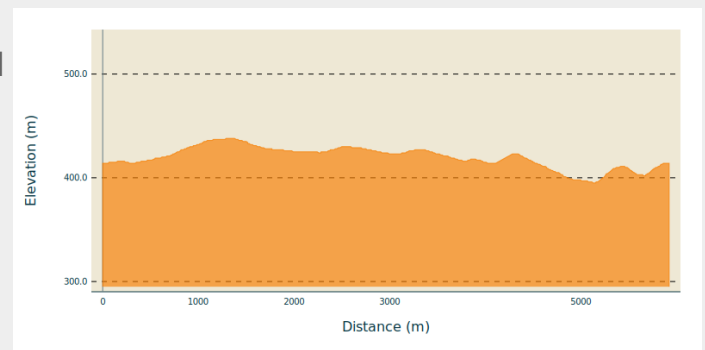

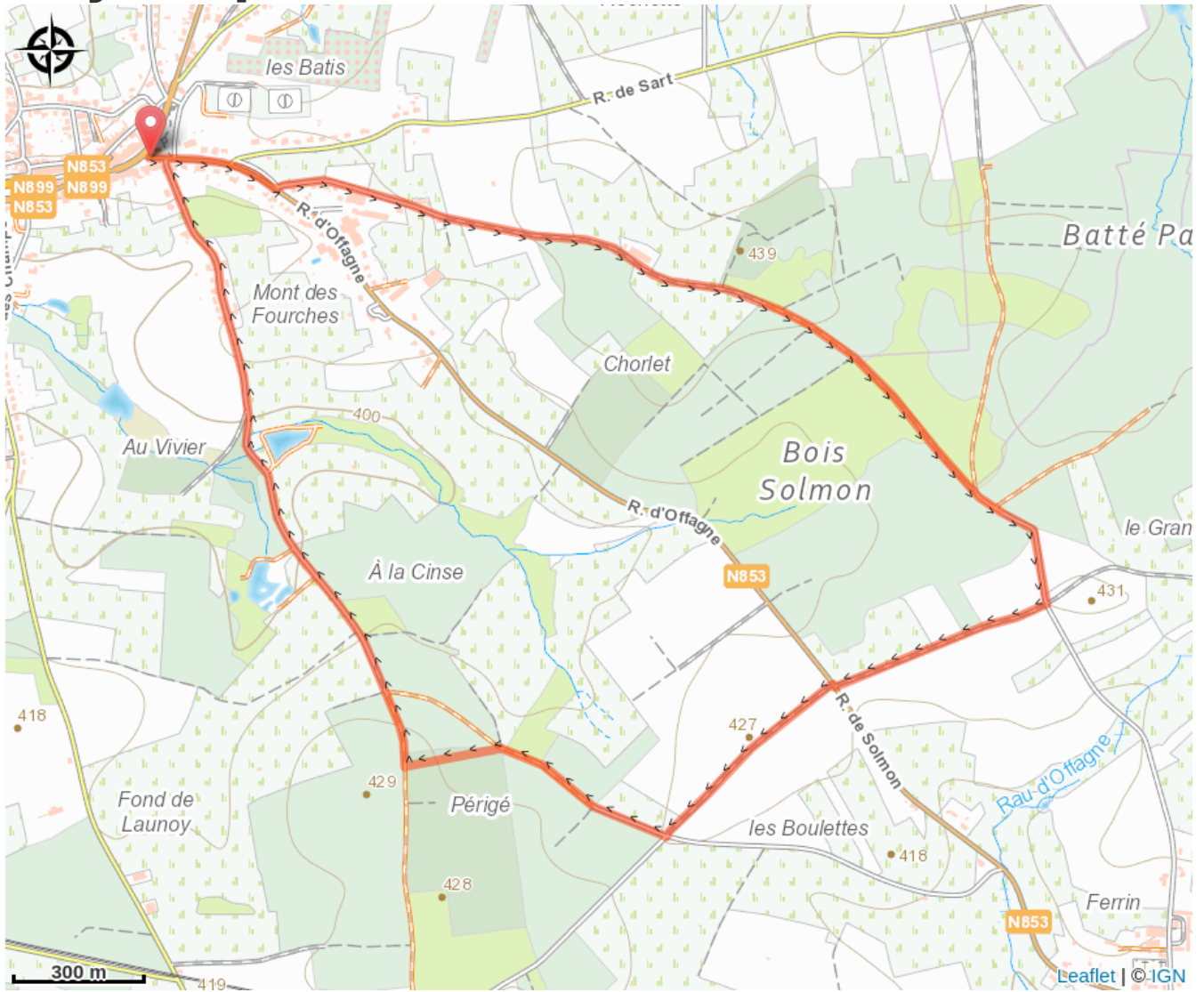
This easy and attractive walk provides information on the poet Paul Verlaine via 6 educational panels.
